## Personal, Social and Emotional Development


### We will be..

## Understanding the World

### We will be..

Finding out about different celebrations including birthdays, weddings, christenings, harvest, Christmas and Diwali.

We will also be looking at seasonal changes around us and learning about Autumn.

Within our R.E sessions we will be covering the Christian festivals of 'Harvest' and also learning about other celebrations in other faiths.

## Numeracy: Shape, Space and Measure

### We will be..

Continuing and making repeating patterns using various different resources such as paint to print with.

We will be learning about 2D shapes and how we can describe them using mathematical language.

## Numeracy: Number

### We will be..

Learning and recognising numbers 0-5 (and beyond) through number games and interactive activities. We will provide opportunities for the children to gain an understanding of what each number looks and feels like through various counting activities.

## Expressive Arts and Design
