### We will be..

Developing learning basic gym moves in PE, working together with a partner.

We will continue practising our pencil control through morning writing activities and the finger gym.

## Literacy

### We will be..

Imitating and innovating the story of 'Wow! said the owl' by Tim Hopgood.

We will also be learning the sounds that letters make and using them to spell and read 3 and 4 letter words.

## ICT

### We will be..

Learning how to use the I pads to use the literacy/Maths based apps, as well as taking pictures of pictures and models the children make.

We will also be learning how to use simple computer programmes on our interactive whiteboard

## Communication and Language

### We will be..

Developing our speaking and listening skills through talking about the story 'Wow said the Owl'. We will talk about the changes in the seasons and nocturnal animals.

### We will be..

Finding out about Rights and the difference between things we want and things we need. We will also be thinking about how we can be confident to try new activities and take turns cooperatively. Our 'Show and Tell' and 'Consultation' sessions also aim to build confidence and self esteem.

### We will be...




## Numeracy: Shape, Space and Measure

### We will be..

Learning about time through our class text and looking at day and night time.

We will be learning about positional language and using this to play games guiding our partner around obstacles inside and outdoors.

## Numeracy: Number

### We will be..

Learning and recognising numbers 10-20 through number games and interactive activities. We will provide opportunities for the children to gain an understanding of what each number looks and feels like through various counting activities. We will also begin to solve some basic number addition problems.

## Expressive Arts and Design

### We will be learning to..

Recognise the primary colours and watch how these change through colour mixing. We will be using this paint to create pictures of things that makes us go 'Wow' inside our class text. We will learning about new artists and recreating their work on our easel.

During music activities we will be exploring rhythmic patterns and experimenting with loud and soft sounds.
