We will be..

Developing our fine motor skills using tools such as scissors in DT activities making Rosies Hat-

We will also be practising our pencil control through name writing activities and the finger gym.

Through PE and outdoor play we will be developing our gross motor skills through various games and role play activities

Literacy

We will be..

Imitating and innovating the story of 'Rosie's Hat' by Julia Donaldson and Anna Currey, focusing on the rhyming words.

We will also be learning the sounds that letters make and using them to spell and read simple words.

ICT

We will be..

Learning how to use the I pads to use the literacy/Maths based apps, as well as taking pictures of pictures and models the children make.

We will also be learning how to use simple computer programmes on our interactive whiteboard

We will be..

Developing our speaking and listening skills through talking about the story 'Rosie's Hat'. We will talk about the differences between babies and ourselves when we start school.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development



We will be..

Understanding the World

We will be...

Developing an understanding of growth and changes over time through the story of 'Rosie's Hat'. Looking closely at how babies change over time, as they grow up and become more independent. We will also look to the future and talk about different jobs and what the children would like to be when they grow up.

We will also be looking at seasonal changes around us and learning about Autumn.

Numeracy: Shape, Space and Measure

We will be..

Continuing and making repeating patterns using various different resources such as paint to print with.

We will be learning about 2D shapes and how we can describe them using mathematical language.

Numeracy: Number

We will be..

Learning and recognising numbers 0-10 (and beyond) through number games and interactive activities. We will provide opportunities for the children to gain an understanding of what each number looks and feels like through various counting activities.

Singing number rhymes to help us learn what numbers come before and after each other.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to..

Recognise the primary colours and watch how these change through colour mixing. We will be using this paint to create pictures of the seaside similar to the one in our story 'Rosie's Hat'.

We will be making character masks for the reading area which will help to develop accurate cutting skills.

During music activities we will be exploring rhythmic patterns and experimenting with loud and soft sounds.
