We are delighted to inform you that Year 3 will be having swimming lessons from Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at Selby Leisure Centre.

**NB- due to school trips there will be a slight schedule change Edelweiss will swim on Thursday and Hollyhock will swim on Friday – this will be a one off alteration.**

The children will have a 30 minute lesson every Thursday with qualified instructors which will last right until the end of the summer term. The cost per child per week is £2. Please send this in with your child each Thursday morning.

A quick reminder that children will require:

- Full swimsuit for girls (no bikinis) labelled
- Swim shorts for boys (these should not be too long as they restrict the leg movement in the water, labelled.
- A towel – labelled.
- A suitable bag which is labelled (we have found in the past that carrier bags rarely last the trip to and from the leisure centre).
- Long hair tied back.
- Earrings removed. If your child's earrings are not removed they will be asked to do so by a member of school or centre staff. Leisure centre staff advise us that tape which covers the earrings can often cause blockages in the pool and rarely stays on the ears therefore removal is the safest option for everyone.

We are sure that the children will relish this learning opportunity and we thank you for your patience. Please see the office staff or fill in the form attached if you need to advise us of any medical conditions your child may have, otherwise there is no reason to return the form.
