Paediatric First Aid Awareness

Selby Adult Learning and Skills Service and offering a FREE Paediatric First Aid Awareness course for parents of children in schools. The course runs for one session of two hours and covers an introduction to the following:-

Aim

To give learners an awareness of aspects of Paediatric First Aid

Outcomes

- To have an awareness of how to act in an emergency and get further help if necessary
- To appreciate the importance of keeping calm
- To be able to recognise common childhood injuries and illnesses

The course has been designed to give parents confidence when dealing with common childhood emergencies and illnesses. The course gives basic information on Choking, Shock, Bleeding (including nose bleeds), Fractures, Burns and Scalds, Common childhood illnesses including Asthma, Meningitis and Septicaemia, Head injuries and Fainting. The course also includes demonstrations on How to help a choking infant/child and the recovery position.

It briefly touches on CPR by use of a short film clip however; due to length of course it is not possible to train delegates the complete CPR procedure.

This course does not qualify delegates in Emergency First Aid; they would need to attend further training to achieve a First Aid qualification.
